Cassette Installation

• Pull the ribbons from the cassette frame (Part 4) taking out the infill strips (F25) to expose the pre drilled holes.





• Mark the location(s) of these holes (Fig 28) the inner frame (F3) making sure it is level. Once you are happy with the alignment you can drill some pilot holes using a centre punch on the marked location to avoid drill bit slipping and damaging the frame) then screw the cassette frame (F4) with some self-tapping screws to the inner frame (F3), making sure that the blackout blinds are at the bottom and close upwards.






Finally, peel off the protective film from the outer cassette and remove the drain plugs from the water holes (Fig 35 -36) at the bottom of the window leaving the top plugs in.
